## **TO ENTER YOUR PUBLICATIONS INTO THE BIBLIOGRAPHY, WE REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING:**

### **1. JOURNAL ARTICLES**

- DOI number,
- or a link to the article online,
- or a PDF of the article.

### **2. CONFERENCE PAPERS/ABSTRACTS/POSTERS**

- a link to the conference proceedings online (ideally full-text access),
- or the proceedings in PDF or printed form (will be returned).

### **3. UNPUBLISHED CONFERENCE PRESENTATIONS**

- details of the conference,
- title and date of the presentation,
- authors.

### **4. INTERVIEWS (RADIO, TV, NEWSPAPERS), RADIO AND TV SHOWS**

- a link to the online recording or article,
- name of the journalist,
- date of publication/broadcast.



## 5. WORKING REPORTS

### A) TO OBTAIN AN IJS-DP NUMBER:

- title of the report,
- author(s).

The IJS-DP number must be stated on the title page.

If the document is confidential, please indicate this clearly (e.g., IJS-DP XXX, confidential).

### B) TO ENTER A WORKING REPORT INTO THE SYSTEM:

- a PDF of the report with the IJS-DP number clearly indicated, or
- if the document is confidential, please provide at least the title page and the following details:
  - total number of pages,
  - whether the report includes an abstract and in which language,
  - whether the report includes illustrations/graphs,
  - whether a bibliography is included and on which page it appears.

C) ALL (CO-)AUTHORS MUST BE CLEARLY LISTED AS SUCH (E.G., AUTHORS OF THE REPORT OR REPORT PREPARED BY: ...).

DO NOT LIST THEM MERELY AS PROJECT COLLABORATORS OR REVIEWERS.

### GENERAL NOTES:

– For newly employed researchers, please also include your field of work and keywords associated with your publications.

– If you already have a researcher ID (ARIS), please include it as well.

This ID is sometimes not yet linked to your name in the COBISS database, which may prevent you from generating your bibliography in SICRIS.



## **TO ENTER YOUR PUBLICATIONS INTO DIRROS, WE REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING:**

### **A) IF THE ARTICLE HAS A CREATIVE COMMONS (CC) LICENSE:**

- APC (Article Processing Charges): Information about any publication fees paid by the authors for open access.
- Information about which project funded the publication.

### **B) IF THE ARTICLE DOES NOT HAVE A CREATIVE COMMONS (CC) LICENSE:**

- AAM (Author Accepted Manuscript): the peer-reviewed version of the article that has been accepted for publication (also referred to as a post-print).
- Details about funders and projects related to the article.
- If possible, please also include the license agreement to verify the archiving conditions set by the publisher.

### **! IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

**IF THE ARTICLE DOES NOT HAVE A CC LICENSE, IT DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR OPEN ACCESS.**

**HOWEVER, IT CAN STILL BE ENTERED INTO DIRROS — AS LONG AS WE RECEIVE THE INFORMATION LISTED IN POINT B.**
